

TATSFIELD NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The public consultation of the Tatsfield Draft Neighbourhood Plan has now finished.

The weekend event had 30 attendees over the 2 days

Comments from those attendees included:

- Transport & Infrastructure - Speed humps on Approach Road into the village, no more than 40mph –
- Congestion & Parking in the Village Centre – Why not have a one way system down Westmore and back out through Paynesfield
- Community Aspiration - Sand path up to Tatsfield Green –
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- If ever the Ship came up for sale could it be converted in to a Nursing Home to help keep older residents together. An easy access for bus.-
- Housing The conclusion even for good reasons is a disappointing result for the young people of Tatsfield future in the village –
- Section 8 Target of 2050 much too long
- Wind or Solar energy should be a priority
- Housing any new houses should be sustainable and energy efficient

A huge amount of work has been put in to this plan I fully support the plan.

On line and written responses:-

In the two dozen responses to the consultation, the main concern was maintaining Tatsfield's position in the Green Belt and the retention of its natural environment. This point was made eight times.

The need for an improved bus service had seven mentions.

There were six references to not being resistant to new designs of properties or appreciations of the range of different styles in the village.

The need for affordable housing and for bungalows for 'downsizers' each attracted five mentions.

There were four references to the 'dark skies' issue.
