#### 2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST (relating to items on the agenda)

### 3. Approve and sign the MINUTES of the previous meeting held on 18th October 2021

108F/1121 It was resolved that the minutes reflected a true and accurate record of the meeting held on 18th October 2021. They were duly signed by the Chair.

### 4. Review Asset Register

The Clerk had spent some time on rewriting the PC's Asset Register so that it was presented in a more user-friendly format. 109F/1121 This was agreed by members and signed by the Chairman.

### 5. Grant requests 2022-23

The Clerk had prepared a summary of all requests received and those anticipated during 2022-23.

The Clerk had circulated the full submissions to members ahead of the meeting.

Requests received:

Not So Young – has requested £282 to cover or part cover the costs of a trips to the Curzon Cinema in the Village Hall, to include refreshment bags.

110F/1121 Members agreed the grant request of £282.

Parish Magazine – has requested £750 towards the production / printing costs of the magazine.

111F/1121 Members agreed to the request for a £750 grant.

Composting Group - has requested £625 to cover the cost of servicing the shredding machine and the mower. 112F/1121 Members agreed to the grant request of £625.

TIB – has requested £1,200.

113F/1121 Members agreed the grant request of £1,200.

There are other grants made by the Parish Council throughout the year:

TACG - insurance. This year's insurance had cost £145.

114F/1121 Members agreed to set aside £145 to cover the insurance next year.

Remembrance Service – A Dave Bishop organised event, funded by the Parish Council. Estimated to be £650 (this year's cost)

115F/1121 Members agreed to budget £650 towards the Remembrance Service costs.

Christmas Carol Singalong - A Dave Bishop organised event, funded by the Parish Council. Estimated to be £350 (this year's cost).

116F/1121 Members agreed to budget £350 towards the Christmas Carol Singalong costs.

Citizens Advice, Oxted – CA does not usually submit a grant request until late spring and does not ask for a specified amount. In recent years, the Parish Council has granted £250. However, Jason Syrett had attended the AGM in September and reported that the organisation's finances were in good shape.

117F/1121 Members agreed a possible grant of £50 to CA Oxted.

## 6. Budget 2022-23

# a) Check over final draft budget and approve for submission to full council

118F/1121 Members resolved to set the Neighbourhood Plan budget line (4291) for 2022-23 at £500. 119F/1121 Members resolved to set the Aileen McHugo Building Maint/R budget line (4230) at £5,000.

This would leave a surplus of £8,855 in the budget.

120F/1121 Members resolved to move £8,000 into reserves to replace monies used for tree works in 2021/22.

121F/1121 Following the above amendments, members approved the budget for 2022/23.

## b) Agree Precept figure to submit to full council for approval

122F/1121 Members resolved to set the Precept for 2022-23 at £55,000.
